
The Abstract range takes inspiration from two main trends for 2021 - Serenity and Geometrics. Serenity encourages a natural rhythm and balance to modern life, taking influence from Japanese culture and traditions. Shape and patterning are key to this trend with links to Origami and concertina folds. Light and shadow play across the surface of the tiles when fitted in unusual lay patterns to create simple vet effective decoration.

Colours are captured on a



spectrum scale within the trend. from the architectural colours of stone and steel, to the pastel variations of softer, more playful

The look also sits comfortably within the Geometric surface trend, a staple of design schemes for years now. Chevrons remain vital to this trend, along with the introduction of smoother, more rounded shapes across which the Abstract range straddles. (Abstract Collection, from £75.22m2, Johnson Tiles. They also have an outlet store and offer an NHS staff discount).



Next up is Karuun, (see image previous page) a man-made material processed from rattan, a climbing palm which grows quicker than trees. It relies on biodiversity to survive and won't flourish in a monoculture, so supporting its cultivation actively helps preserve our planet's rainforests and gives local communities a sustainable

It has a unique capillary structure, which is simultaneously permeable to both air and light, while also being strong and tactile. A hybrid of sorts, it's lightweight as well





as decorative, that lends itself perfectly to creating wall features with an original look.

Shellshock (see images opposite page) began fifteen years ago when a trip to China to visit a university friend ignited an idea, and a romance. While visiting a beach, founders Jonathan Kern and his friend came across a van selling shell photo frames and tissue boxes. "To cut a long story short we bought the artisan business and started introducing mother of pearl for interiors," Ionathan explains. "I married my business partner's sister and we now live in the Loire Valley in France, having refurbished a 14th century Manor House," Shellshock supplies quality products to hotels, cruise ships, casinos and private vachts in 83 countries around the world. Their extensive collection includes these beautiful. sustainably sourced threedimensional wooden mosaics,

made from reclaimed ship timber. The mother of pearl products are created by lavering paper-thin slices together to achieve a luxurious finish. Such tactile textures will add interest and depth, with the added charm of an artisan's touch and interesting provenance. Grey and Midnight Blue. Each panel is created from FSC certified materials and will transform a flat space into an uber cool one. (From £189, Acupanel, available from The Wood Veneer Hub).

The last products I'm sharing are these beautiful Palm panels, reminiscent of LA boulevards lined with gently swaying palms.

Architects and designers love them for their versatility, they're available in translucent form, which work in place of glass as shower screens, sliding doors, room dividers or backlit wall panels for example, and in solid colours for wall panelling and countertop fabrication. Manufactured through a layering process of color, patterns, images or even textiles, that make creative possibilities limited only by your imagination. (Contact 3Form for options and pricing).

There's so many more surface options to really bring your home to life, and one place you absolutely must check out is Material Lab in London. It's a designer's paradise full of samples (including some of those featured here) that will exceed way beyond your imagination. I was like a kid in a candy store when I visited and I guarantee you will be too!
